







SWIM Registry Overview – What is it?





- The SWIM Registry provides consolidated information on SWIM services. It stores structured descriptions that facilitate the discovery and comparability of services.
- The registry implements:
 - Discovery functionality (search, subscription) that enables to identify registered services, obtain their descriptions and follow up their evolution.
 - Registration functionality (workflow, forms, categorizations) that enables the controlled and structured registration of services in the registry

SWIM Registry Overview – Why use it?





- The SWIM Registry supports service implementation and reuse:
 - Enabling <u>service providers</u> (mainly those sharing information over SWIM) to increase visibility (and consequent adoption) of their services.
 - Improving the efficiency of <u>service consumers</u> in services that address their needs and facilitating the implementation of consuming interfaces.
- The SWIM Registry is part of the SWIM Common Infrastructure Component defined by the Commission Implementation Regulation EU No 716/2014 [3]. The Regulation specifies that
 - "The registry, which shall be used for publication and discovery of information regarding service consumers and providers, the logical information model, SWIM enabled services, business, technical, and policy information".

SWIM Registry - Status
